


SCISSORS




1. FOLD YOUR PIECE OF PAPER IN HALF LENGTHWAYS AND CUT IT INTO TWO LONG STRIPS.






2. TAKE ONE STRIP AND FOLD IT INTO EIGHT EQUAL SECTIONS—YOU WANT THE POLDS TO RESEMBLE AN ACCORDION.

3. IT SHOULD LOOK LIKE THIS.



4. PLACE YOUR PAPER ACCORDION ON THE TABLE WITH THE CUT EDGE



5. DRAW HALF A DOLL ALONG THE LEFT EDGE, WITH ARMS EXTENDING TO THE RIGHT EDGE. 6. CUT DUT YOUR HALF PERSON, BUT BE CAREFUL NOT TO CUT THE FOLDED EDGE THAT HOLDS HIM/HER TO THEIR OTHER HALF!





7. UNFOLD YOUR PAPER PEOPLE AND DECORATE.
